Another big event is **Camp Friendship**, which provides a week of special activities for our Pediatric residents. This delightful program has now become an annual event for our young residents and their caregivers.

This year's theme was space/rockets. Activities included rocket crafts, a costume parade and a field trip to the Strasenberg Planetarium. The children also enjoyed a bonfire and had self-portraits drawn by a local artist which are now displayed on the unit.

MCH CLINIC

Consultative Services, better known as The Clinic, is a group that operates under the Nursing Department at MCH and works with contracted specialists who provide our residents with a wide range of routine medical care that they would otherwise have to receive at outside facilities.



The Clinic has providers in the following fields that have contracted with MCH and are credentialed by Monroe County: Audiology, Dental, Dermatology, Ophthalmology, Podiatry, Psychiatry and Urology.



The dentist is here twice a week, and hygienists see residents four times a week. The podiatrist is here once a week, and the audiologist is here three times a month. The dermatologist and urologist are here twice a month and the ophthalmologist is here once a month.

The Clinic also facilitates several remote psychiatric sessions a week through the URMC Telepsych program that allows our residents to receive care by way of telecommunications technology.

Everyone from respite residents to

rehab patients to long-term care residents at MCH benefits from Clinic services. In 2023, over 4000 appointments were scheduled. In 2024 it is anticipated that over 4500 appointments will be scheduled.

Much appreciation to the dedicated Clinic staff, and the staff of transporters who bring the residents to their appointments.
